



NOVEMBER UPDATE

Not much to update on TTT. Why? Because the city of South Portland has not received a response to the letter they sent to Suncor, the owner of the Hill Street Tank Farm and the Portland Pipeline that transports crude oil to Montreal.

The city wrote on September 7: *“We believe this is an opportunity for Suncor to demonstrate corporate leadership, environmental responsibility, and goodwill by working proactively with the City and its residents. A transparent and voluntary divestment that incorporates cleanup and paves the way for redevelopment will benefit all parties – and stands as a legacy decision with lasting impact for the people of South Portland.”*

Toss the Tanks fully supports the city's efforts. It has been more than 7 weeks since Suncor received this letter. The city deserves a response from Suncor.

The city of South Portland and the Toss the Tanks campaign believe there can be a “win-win solution,” but this will not happen if Suncor does not come to the table.
